## CAMP SHIELD FAMILY BEREAVEMENT RETREAT AUGUST 26 - 28, 2022

Our Camp SHIELD Family Bereavement Retreat is designed to help families, who are beyond devastated after burying a child, understand they are not alone and that their feelings of loss are normal. We provide a safe place for children and adults to share feelings, meet others on the same grief journey, and have fun while learning how to grieve in an emotionally healthy way.

Camp SHIELD is offered annually for parents, grandparents and siblings. This interactive and supportive weekend retreat offers activities such as music and singing, games, arts and crafts, family entertainment, group sharing and opportunities for families to simply spend time together.

A special service of remembrance gives each family a chance to honor their loved one.

Camp SHIELD is staffed by professional counselors, social workers, chaplains, and others who have experience working with the bereaved. Community volunteers are also integral to the Camp SHIELD program.

Camp Kinard, located in Batesburg-Leesville, SC, is the location for Camp SHIELD. Camp Kinard occupies 325 acres 20 miles west of Columbia and its unique facilities provide a great retreat experience in a nurturing, fully-accessible environment.

Camp SHIELD is offered free of charge for families (up to ten members) except for a small \$50 administrative fee.
